Mendocino Woodlands Campsite Three. The camp is set among a mature Redwood/Douglas Fir forest, creating a beautiful, peaceful setting. A small creek runs alongside the camp.

Cost includes delicious community meals with offerings for vegans, vegetarians, and omnis.

Substances

Cost / Deposit / Refund Policy

Campers bring their own bedding and optional tent. A bring-list will be sent with the camp packet in mid-Summer.

Discount for registration and payment by May 31. **Deposit** \$100 per person (age 5-up) reserves space, and is strictly nonrefundable once accepted to camp via email confirmation.
