



When we are gone, they will remain Wind and rock, fire and rain They will remain, when we return The wind will blow, and the fire will burn



Witchcamps include all levels of experience. Camps welcome anyone in accord with Reclaiming's Principles of Unity. Visit Reclaiming.org/about


